### Whoever remains in me bears fruit in plenty.

Jesus uses the metaphor of the vine to highlight the intimate relationship he has with his friends and the disciples. There is no separating trunk from branches. We are all one with him to make a flourishing fruit-bearing vines. We and Jesus are at home in each other; we are part of him and we cannot function otherwise. We as a community work in union with Christ. A divided community is spiritually doomed, so too does grapevine gossips, fake interpretations of The Truth etc. The trunk must be firmly planted in Christ for each branch to grow up and out, multiplying in followers. With each season we grow with love, and act and speak of Christ's love. The more we allow ourselves to be transfused with his life-giving Spirit, the richer will be our harvest, and the more good we shall be empowered to do in the world. We can then withstand any storm in our lives.
