**Response:** God mounts the throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord.

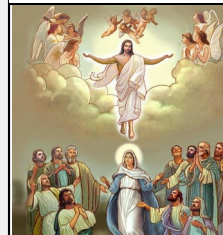
**Second Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23**
