### We need not fear: God is fully in charge.

We may never see the full meaning of what we endure in this life, but the vision of God will reassure us that nothing happens outside of God's will and all is for the purpose of preparing us for eternal love. We are called to pray, to admit our fears and to take what reasonable steps we may to avoid harm. What we should never do is to think for a moment that the Lord does not care. We need to trust in God in our daily journey and step out of the habits that achieve little. This week, a call was taken from a Vinnies volunteer about a local person in need. The volunteer shared his own experience when as a non practising catholic, he was very sick in hospital. Eddy received the anointing of the sick and felt an immediate healing. He now says the Rosary daily. He recorded his journey on YouTube, for us to hear his message. Search—Muslim Taxi driver sent me to Church. Eddie Borovnjak is in the process of writing his book on his miracles.

### **Reflection:**

Fear is one of the most paralysing and painful experiences in life. There are many things we can fear, but most often, the cause of our fear is the evil one trying to deter us from faith and hope in Christ Jesus.

Often in times of fear in life, we lose sight of Jesus. We turn in on ourselves and focus on the cause of our fear. But our goal must be to turn from the cause of fear in life and look for Jesus ; Who is always compassionate and is always walking toward us in the midst of our fear and struggle.

Reflect, today, upon whatever it is that causes you the most fear and anxiety in life. What is it that leads you to interior confusion and struggle? Once you identify the source, turn your eyes from that to our Lord. See Him walking toward you in the midst of whatever you struggle with, saying to you, "Take courage, it is I, do not be afraid!"

***Prayer: Lord, once again I turn to Your most compassionate Heart. Help me to lift my eyes toward You and to turn away from the sources of my anxiety and fear in life. Fill me with faith and hope in You and give me the courage I need to put all my trust in You. Jesus, I trust in You. Amen***
