Today's readings are about the personal love connection between the Eternal Presence and human beings. We are connected with God through our covenant relationship whether by pure devotion or the fear of God. Through Jesus, we no longer sacrifice animals to please God, but present ourselves (like Jesus did) as the perfect offering to God. In time, our connection to God is characterised by love of and no longer commanded but genuine love. When the Pope received his covid vaccine, he did it as an act of love. He loved us all and wanted to lead us into protection. God also asked that how we treat or respect ourselves, we should do the same to our neighbours.

The memorial mass are for our dearly departed members of Christ the King.

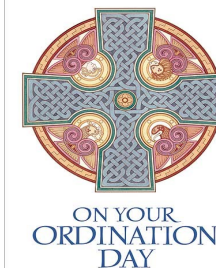
