### Charity and Arms-giving.

Both the widows mentioned today were willing to give at great personal cost. They gave lovingly, trusting the God would provide for them. God is well worth all the love we can ever lavish on him. Actual amounts of money pledged to God's work will vary according to circumstances; but the attitude behind really generous giving does not alter in proportion. God's love, healings and forgiveness is free and not tied to the size of the givings. But Jesus watches over the treasury of the heart, and feels that there should be an obligation of the wealthy who chose to live in opulence or trade in unscrupulous activity, to change by considering compassion and charity to ones at the bottom of the social and economic ladder. Those less fortunate always trust in God that "God will Provide" at the end of the day.

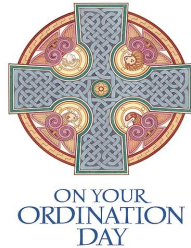
