

Safeguarding of children updates.

For those volunteers who are engaged in child-related work will require to complete the Safeguarding Induction Training prior to commencing. Those who completed their online training 3 years ago will require a refresher course. 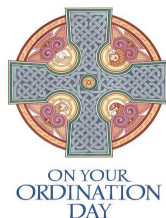

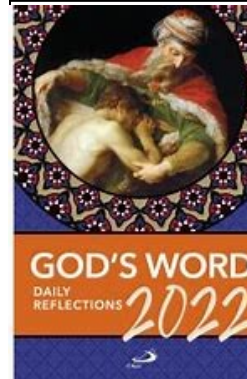
