
Memorial Mass Candleholders

Safeguarding of children updates.

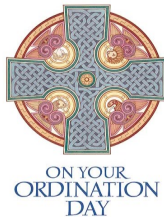
For those volunteers who are engaged in child-related work will require to complete the Safeguarding Induction Training prior to commencing. Those who completed their online training 3 years ago will require a refresher course. For more details are found on our website under Resources. **To register for training please register via the link <https://forms.gle/9ebT3voEAtfP7P8R9>.**

The Archdiocese safeguarding team has checked our register for volunteers compliances and found that - 46% of volunteers have done the safeguarding training, 51% of volunteers WWCC has either expired, not provided or missing details that cannot be verified. In coming weeks the Parish office will be following these up. Our website has all the resources to fulfil the requirements of our safeguarding obligations.
