The NSW parliament has passed a child safe scheme, which has 10 standards which will be mandatory for faith-based organisations to comply with in 2022.

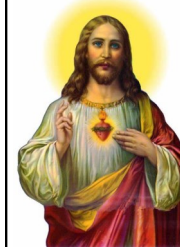
