First Reading: Isaiah 42:1-4, 6-7

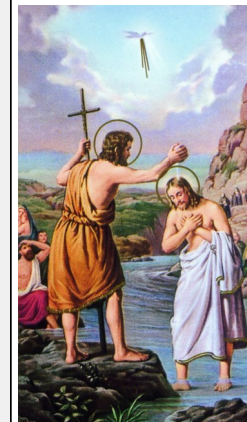
Response: *O bless the Lord, my soul!*

As Messiah, identifying with his people, Jesus receives the baptism of repentance, and as he does so, the Spirit of God descends upon him,

showing him, beyond all doubts, that he is the promised Christ who is to save his people from their sins. Christ journey to spread the news and teachings is just about to begin. Our faith and hope lies on our Saviour and his mission to change peoples way's and bring fresh hope for the future.

The NSW parliament has passed a child safe scheme, which has 10 standards which will be mandatory for faith-based organisations to comply with in 2022.



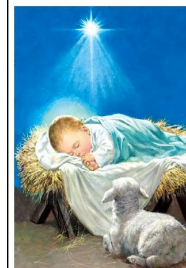
