First Reading: Isaiah 62:1-5

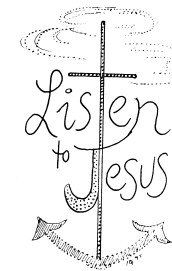
Response: Proclaim God's marvellous deeds to all the nations.

The wedding at Cana is one of many Gospel readings that have more than one message in it. It is one of the first known to

show Jesus's ability to use His power to change water to wine and show a sign of God's abundant love for us. The reading indicates that the love of God over his people is similar to the love and care a groom gives to his bride in marriage. But it is also one that says—Listen to Jesus, follow his instructions to receive secure the fullness of life and love.

Check in and masks are mandatory in our Church. We wear our masks as a way to protect others, as a way of love and respect for others. Allow a distance of at least 1.5 metres between each family group.

We are saddened of the news of the passing of Beniamino (Ben) Peresan. Ben is another parishioner who made a great mark on the early life of Christ the King Church. He has left us, but his works in marble in the Church are reminders of his craft. Ben will be farewelled at our parish on Friday 21st January at 10:30am.

It is with great sadness that I advise of the death of Mrs Gloria Fisher, mother of our Archbishop. I ask that you all please keep Archbishop Anthony and his family in your prayers. Mrs Fisher grew up in China and the Philippines, with a Spanish-Basque father and an Egyptian-born (half-Italian, half-Romanian mother) and was a registered nurse. Alongside her husband Colin, Mrs Fisher was a committed St Vincent de Paul Society volunteer over many years and no doubt helped inspire Archbishop Fisher in his vocation to religious life. We also had the sad news of the death of former Catholic Women’s League President, Esther Doyle. Mrs Doyle was part of the NSW Catholic Church Committee for Pope John Paul II's visit in 1986 and was President of the CWL for many years, being awarded a Croce Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice in 1986, as well as an Order of Australia Medal for her contributions to the life of the Church and society. Please join me in praying for the repose of the soul of Mrs Gloria Fisher, Mrs Esther Doyle and for all the faithful departed.
