Commitment to Discipleship.

The theme running through today's readings is that of Discipleship.

In the first reading is about Elisha who is more of a charismatic free spirit than a professional prophet. Elisha is then captivated by Elijah, one of the greatest Hebrew prophets. Elisha receives power though Elijah, changes his way of life and embraces his calling. Been one of God's chosen one means commitment and a way of life where you are free from baggage wearing you down. To be genuine disciple in the years after Jesus death, you had to be committed through baptism and living according to the teaching of Christ. You didn't require to be Jewish, you only needed to serve one another in love , and the other fruits of the Spirit such as joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness and self control. Let the minds be guided by the Spirit, then our actions will follow as Spirit-filled. Would you welcome Jesus' disciple in your home? Is your home filled with the fruit of the Spirit? Jesus is calling for the "Spiritually alive" to follow him. Leave you human duties behind. Those who put their human duties before the commitment of discipleship are not putting the importance of what Jesus is offering - true life. Following Jesus is the way to live a quality Christian life that amounts to living in the kingdom of God.
