Entrance Antiphon: Your merciful love, O God, we have received in the midst of your temple. Your praise, O God, like your name, reaches the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with saving justice.

First Reading: Isaiah 66:10-14

Response: Let all the earth cry out to God with joy.

Second Reading: Galatians 6:14-18

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! May the peace of Christ reign in your hearts, and the fullness of his message live within you. Alleluia!

Gospel: Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

Communion Antiphon: Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed the man who seeks refuge in him.

Peace is part of the very nature of God, and flows from him like a river. Jesus' mission is for peace and unity in the world. The Church is a continuance of the mission of the Son of God from the Father. Christ himself came as a human being because he was sent by the Father. The first 12 apostles, were said to represent the 12 sons of Jacob and 12 tribes of Israel. The second sending, Jesus is sending 72 apostles (symbolic of the 72 nations described in Genesis 10; and nations that descended from Noah after the flood) to the expanding church. It's mission is to unite in peace, faith and invite Christ's teaching about the Kingdom of God to the people. Not all people welcomed the News, and that was respected. It never was about reward for this mission, even though it was dangerous, but knowing that the Kingdom of God is in our reach if we choose this mission, is all it takes to be the next disciple of Christ.

Eucharist to the sick and to Aged Care Residence.

We have been advised that only one visitor can visit one aged care resident. Due to this, we will delay visiting Aged Care residence with communion. However, we will shortly be commencing our visits to aged and sick people in their homes.
