Welcoming Christ

The theme of today's reading is hospitality not just accepting and treating visitors in our home, but welcoming the Divine Presence in our lives. Christ lives among us and those who welcome him. In the first reading, Abraham recognises God's presence in the visitation of the three travellers (one which was Sarah) and welcomes them in his warm wholehearted middle Eastern way, by washing their feet and bringing the best food. In the Psalm, it reflects that one cannot be a guest of the Divine Presence if he/she is not in solidarity with the people they encounter in their lives. In the Gospel Jesus is welcomed to Martha and Mary, sisters of Lazarus. As Mary is sitting and listening to Jesus' every words, Martha is busy preparing the meal. Jesus is implying that Mary's priority is her spiritual life over the distraction of house duties. The word of God is the priority as it is life-directing, and allows us to centre our thoughts and actions. Such focus enables us to rank our priorities and develop a singleness of purpose. Jesus also wouldn't want food prepared with fuss or perfection. These days perfectionism is becoming a curse of the idealist who must do things so well, that it becomes a focal point; to a point that the reason for the main event or celebration is lost over the item that is over done. Therefore the priority of the gathering is lost.

Sisters of St Josephs celebrate 150 years in NSW on 16th July.

Julian Edmund Tenison Woods & Sr Mary MacKillop were the co-founder of the Sisters of Saint Joseph in Penola in South Australia on 19th March 1866. The congregation founded on the commitment to education in Australia and developing ministries amongst aboriginal communities, social justice concern in each State. The sister of Saint Joseph celebrate 150 years of the Congregation's presence in NSW since their arrival in Perthville (10km from Bathurst) on 16 July 1872. We congratulate the Sisters of St Joseph for their commitment to children and families in the State of NSW.



Mary MacKillop writes to her mother Flora on 14 May 1867:
"I have such an earnest longing for the Order of St Joseph and know well how hard it will be to get it established here, but everything God blesses will prosper and surely His blessing attends this holy Order; no other is so fitted for the wants of this Colony."
