Communion Antiphon: Blessed are the merciful, for they shall receive mercy. Blessed are the clean of heart, for they shall see God.

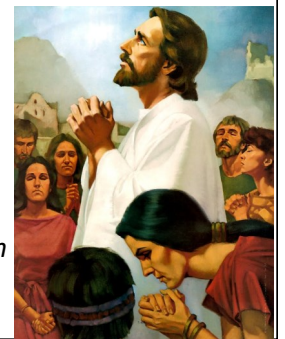
Praying to our Father.

The theme of today's reading is about asking for our spiritual needs. In the first reading we hear of Abraham pleading with God to save the city of Sodom for the sake of the good people living there.

Abraham approaches God with humble respect, but with earnest, is able to negotiate from fifty good men to save the town to five if were found. Jesus is asking us to form a relationship with God. Teaching the disciples how to pray, he uses the Jewish prayer found in Berachot– as we know it as “Our Father”.

The prayer praises God, keep us safe and forgive others who have wronged you. By forgiving, you lift the burden from yourself. The prayer ask not to test God but trust in him. God is happy to hear any

prayer, even petitions as it unifies us to him and calms our concerns and enriches us spiritually in the process. By praying you have faith and connection with God, with faith you have trust in Gods plan for what is good for each one of us. Just ask God.
