Trust God and be ready for him

Today's readings focus on the relationship between God and the covenant – the obligation of both parties to be faithful to their commitment and to do favours for each other.

The first reading from the book of wisdom; The writer retraces the steps of the chosen people to show them God in the act of saving his flock. God works in wonders and sometimes they are hidden, but those who are alert and sensitive to the signs of Christ will see his presence. Second reading is about Faith as the foundation of a life lived in hope which built a future for God's people. In the Gospel, Jesus also emphasises to be prepared and carry lightly for when he calls, that window of opportunity will not remain open for long. What you take is what matters to the heart—we are God's priceless treasure, this is what matters.

In the parable– the master is responsible to supply the community with the food and good living conditions in order for them to provide better service in return. This refers to us, to nourish our whole body, not just with food and shelter, but to nourish our mind spiritually to grow.

In the past weeks we have been printing children's worksheets relating to today's Gospels. They are found on the table at the back of the church.

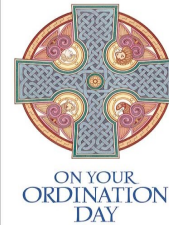
