Entrance Antiphon: Turn your eyes, O God, our shield; and look on the face of your anointed one; one day within your courts is better than a thousand elsewhere.

First Reading: Isaiah 38:4-6

Response: Lord, come to my aid!

Second Reading: Hebrews 12:1-4

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! My sheep listen to my voice, says the Lord; I know them and they follow me. Alleluia!

Gospel: Luke 12:49-53

Communions Antiphon: With the Lord there is mercy; in him is plentiful redemption.

Following Christ brings hardship, but he will support us.

There is a note of reaction to the unpopular word in today's readings. Nobody wants to hear bad news or hardship, as this will make followers want to avoid the conflict.

In the first reading, there is a siege in Jerusalem by the Babylonians/ Chaldeans. The King of Jerusalem is caught in a precarious political and military predicament, asks for Jeremiah's advice, but doesn't like what the Prophet suggest, namely that Judah capitulate to the Babylonians and accept being overwhelmed by a far superior force. The King sees this offensive as divine punishment on Judah with no way out, but to accept the inevitable.

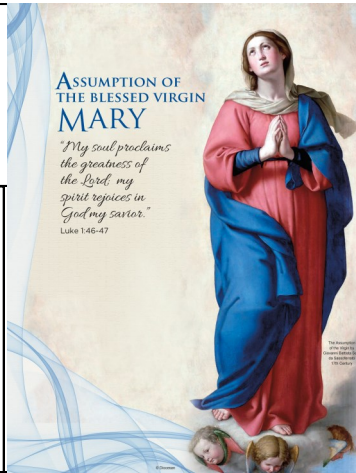
In the Gospel, Jesus is also saying, that he comes in peace, but that his teaching may be challenged by various Jews or family members of the community who follow traditional Judaism. Dividing the family will shake out the complacency that has been held overtime and re-evaluates, challenges and reaffirms what Jesus' teachings are about. That many injustices and conflicts can be resolved with perseverance of allowing Christ's wisdom, strength and love to be exercised in time of conflict and injustice. Jesus asks us all to make the hard choice of being peacemakers in this unsettling and evil world.

Safeguarding requirements

Our Parish safeguarding standards are bound by the agreement with the Archdioceses of Sydney; that all volunteers will require a number of conditions in order to volunteer. All volunteers except linen & altar Society (Church cleaners) require a Working With Children Check number (WWC), which is free to volunteers and is applied via Services NSW website.

The Parish must verify each 6 months, each volunteer in order to receive clearance to help, to do this we require the volunteers DOB, WWC number and correct spelling of surname to be all correct. We then have to send the verified and cleared volunteers list to the Archdioceses. We need your help and co-operation in order to meet these requirements. The following volunteers need to see Father Macwan to obtain the advice on what details is lacking for the clearance. Please assist and return any details required to Father Macwan or the Parish office. Thank you for your co-operation.
