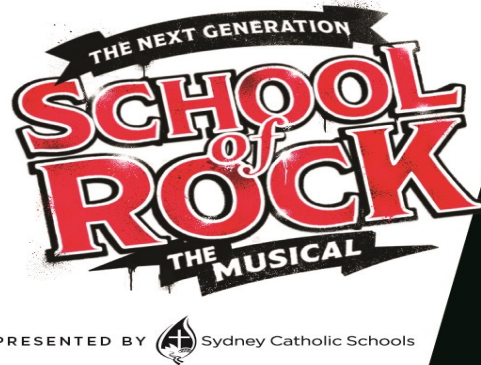
Gospel: Luke 13:22-30

People from all nations will be drawn into God's Kingdom.

The motif in today's readings is about gathering people into the realm of God. Following the Pentecost event, which marked the beginning of the good news movement out to the whole world; backed by the Holy Spirit, the word was getting around to the world via the apostles and their disciples. From the Book of Isaiah, expresses the picture that people coming from all over the world to Jerusalem to acknowledge the God of Israel as the ultimate God for all nations and tribes. In the letter to Hebrews it ask to practice self-discipline and hardship and being like Christ as preparation. In the Gospel, it goes further by asking us to be prepared, connect with God, walk with Christ. If we follow the crowd heading in the wrong direction we will not as individuals fit through the doorway shaped by God made just for us.

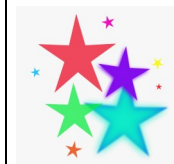

Safeguarding requirements

Our Parish safeguarding standards are bound by the agreement with the Archdioceses of Sydney; that all volunteers will require a number of conditions in order to volunteer. All volunteers except linen & altar Society (Church cleaners) require a Working With Children Check number (WWC), which is free to volunteers and is applied via Services NSW website.

The Parish must verify each 6 months, each volunteer in order receive clearance to help, to do this we require the volunteers DOB, WWC number and correct spelling of surname to be all correct. We then have to send the verified and cleared volunteers list to the Archdioceses. We need your help and co-operation in order to meet these requirements.
