Humility

Today's readings contain messages of practical wisdom. They rest on a foundation of respect, seeing the divine and the potential in others and in the world around us.

In the first reading– the Hebrew text suggest that if we are successful (wealthy) we should remain humble as this brings more respected amongst people. Sirach is also saying to respect the wisdom of the previous generation, as they come with experience and lessons on hardship. In the Gospel, Jesus demonstrates that authentic spirituality comes in the form of gentleness, respect, honesty, charitable and self-giving. With prayer and discernment and taking lessons from the perfect example of Jesus: the humble will be blessed and brought to the full joy of heaven.

This teaching could be applied to the everyday people we admire. The celebrities or better still, our frontline healthcare workers, our parents or mentors. Who is your amazing person in your life?

St Brendan's Friendship club has organised a trip to Canberra on Sat 24th –Sun 25th September 2022.

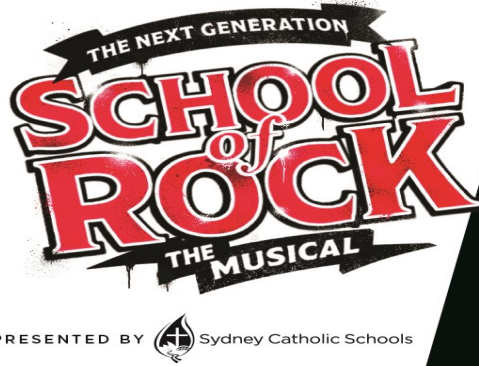

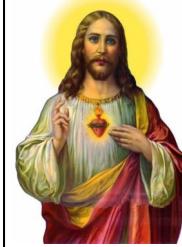
The performance on Tuesday 11th October will be Auslan Interpreted and the performance on Wednesday 12th October will be Audio Described.

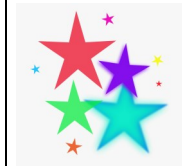

Safeguarding requirements

Our Parish safeguarding standards are bound by the agreement with the Archdioceses of Sydney; that all volunteers will require a number of conditions in order to volunteer. All volunteers except linen & altar Society (Church cleaners) require a Working With Children Check number (WWC), which is free to volunteers and is applied via Services NSW website.

The Parish must verify each 6 months, each volunteer in order receive clearance to help, to do this we require the volunteers DOB, WWC number and correct spelling of surname to be all correct. We then have to send the verified and cleared volunteers list to the Archdioceses. We need your help and co-operation in order to meet these requirements.
