First Reading: Wisdom 9:13-18

I give you my life, you give me yours

The theme of this Sunday readings is about attachment and commitment. In the book of Wisdom, it is about knowing what God wants from us and knowing that we leave everything behind (on our departure) and only our soul is taken up to heaven. In the Second reading, Paul is writing as an old man, still a prisoner of Jesus' Good News mission. He is asking for consent that his child Onesimus be free from this task, no longer a slave, but a dear brother in the Lord. In the Gospel, What Jesus is saying really is this, he is saying- "I give you my life. You give me yours."

"I give without counting the cost. You give me yours without counting the cost."

"I give you my life to teach you how to love as I love. You give me your life to receive my love and bring it to other people. "I begin a mission. You continue it."

Joining Christ can come with a cost, it can be of rejection from others, the cost of going without luxury or comfort, money issues etc. Pope St John Paul reminded us, many Christians have been faithful unto death, shedding their blood for Christ, in modern times.

Jesus always applied a simple living standard when he was on earth. Today, with excessive consumerism and wastage we have attached ourselves to "keeping with the Jones's". What Pope Francis is asking, is to live with less carbon footprint and practice sustainable living. Let us detach from excessive lifestyle, save our planet and attach to Christ.

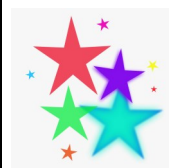

Child Protection Week 5-11 September 2022

When a parish in the Archdiocese of Sydney is called upon to safeguard its community, we are being asked to pro-actively support a culture of care that champions honesty and engagement. The result of this is a community environment where children and young people are valued, heard and protected from harm.

Safeguarding requirements

Our Parish safeguarding standards are bound by the agreement with the Archdioceses of Sydney; that all volunteers will require a number of conditions in order to volunteer. All volunteers except linen & altar Society (Church cleaners) require a Working With Children Check number (WWC), which is free to volunteers and is applied via Services NSW website.

The Parish must verify each 6 months, each volunteer in order receive clearance to help, to do this we require the volunteers DOB, WWC number and correct spelling of surname to be all correct. We then have to send the verified and cleared volunteers list to the Archdioceses. We need your help and co-operation in order to meet these requirements.

The following volunteers need to see Father Macwan to obtain the advice on what details is lacking for the clearance. Please assist and return any details required to Father Macwan or the Parish office. Thank you for your co-operation.
