Entrance Antiphon: Give peace, O Lord, to those who wait for you, that your prophets be found true. Hear the prayers of your servant, and of your people, Israel.

First Reading: Exodus 32:7-11, 13-14

Response: *I will rise and go to my father.*

Second Reading: *Timothy 1:12-17*

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! God was sent to reconcile the world to himself; and the Good News of reconciliation he has entrusted to us. Alleluia!

Gospel: Luke 15:1-32

Communion Antiphon: How precious is your mercy, O God! The children of men seek shelter in the shadow of your wings.

Complete forgiveness.

There is no limit to what God will forgive. All sins are beyond the possibility of forgiveness.

In the first reading God was angry at the Israelites for worshipping a calf, but through Moses influence, God was not vengeful on the people. In the second reading St Paul thanks Jesus for his leadership and mercy, and recognises Him as a saver of sinners of the world.

In the Gospel, through the lost and found parables, Jesus expresses joy at even just one lost and sinful person redeeming their wrong doing and reconciling to God and changing their path through redemption to good.

Pope St John Paul forgave Mehmet who shot him in St Peter's square in Rome in 1981. The survival of the shooting was a miracle in itself. After Mehmet's release from jail, he returned to lay flowers on the tomb of St John Paul II. Twenty six years to that day of the shooting, Mehmet was received into the Catholic Church.

Twenty one years ago today, now know as 9/11 a total of 2,977 people were killed by 4 planes used as missiles on US buildings, that were funded by Al-Qaeda. Have we managed to forgive or do we live with the grudge? Do we allow redemption and allow them to reconcile with God? Jesus says that mercy plays a part in the journey of the redemption. It takes a lot of strength to forgive, but Jesus and Saint John Paul II showed us that the outcome becomes joyful.

Long Term Volunteer Opportunities in the Australia-Pacific Region - The Cagliari Project, Salesians of Don Bosco

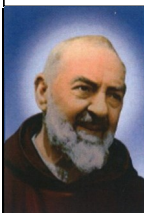

Child Protection Week 5-11 September 2022

When a parish in the Archdiocese of Sydney is called upon to safeguard its community, we are being asked to pro-actively support a culture of care that champions honesty and engagement. The result of this is a community environment where children and young people are valued, heard and protected from harm.

This week– The Archdiocese has printed and delivered an activity book for children between 5-12 years of age. There are a limited amount, copies are available for the children at the back of the church.

Safeguarding requirements

Our Parish safeguarding standards are bound by the agreement with the Archdioceses of Sydney; that all volunteers will require a number of conditions in order to volunteer. All volunteers except linen & altar Society (Church cleaners) require a Working With Children Check number (WWC), which is free to volunteers and is applied via Services NSW website. The Parish must verify each 6 months, each volunteer in order receive clearance to help, to do this we require the volunteers DOB, WWC number and correct spelling of surname to be all correct. We then have to send the verified and cleared volunteers list to the Archdioceses. **WWC check is required in order to volunteer for reading, Eucharist for the sick and for Acolytes.** We need your help and co-operation in order to meet these requirements.
