**Communion Antiphon:** You have laid down your precepts to be carefully kept; may my ways be firm in keeping your statutes.

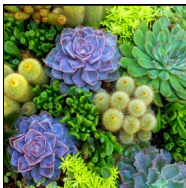
### Good Stewardship.

Today's readings is about inclusiveness of all levels of "wealth" in the human race. That we look after everyone, to feed, home and spiritually nourish all people so that they all can be saved. We must ensure that the institutions of our society are devoted to the well-beings of all citizens. In the first reading, the Lord spoke against those who buy with money the poor for slavery. In the letter of St Paul to Timothy, it reads that we should included everyone in petitions, intercessions and thanksgiving.....and especially "for king & other authority, so that we may be able to live religious and reverent lives in peace and quiet." How timely and true is this sentence, as we mourn the loss of the country's Queen, who was a sign of certainty, stability and had strong faith. She took an interest in all the commonwealth's main issues.

In the Gospel, Jesus says that we cannot hold equal value to both God and money. If we are well trusted with our own wealth and if we work for the wealth of others, than we have a clear conscience to focus on our relationship with God. Pope Francis teaches us that in our faith and devotion to God we must also focus on the help to the poor and the suffering. It is the nearest way to come closer to Jesus. It is also a representative of our Faith in action.

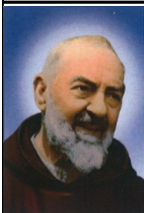

### **Safeguarding requirements**

Our Parish safeguarding standards are bound by the agreement with the Archdioceses of Sydney; that all volunteers will require a number of conditions in order to volunteer. All volunteers except linen & altar Society (Church cleaners) require a Working With Children Check number (WWC), which is free to volunteers and is applied via Services NSW website.

The Parish must verify each 6 months, each volunteer in order receive clearance to help, to do this we require the volunteers DOB, WWC number and correct spelling of surname to be all correct. We then have to send the verified and cleared volunteers list to the Archdioceses. **WWC check is required in order to volunteer for reading, Eucharist for the sick and for Acolytes.** We need your help and co-operation in order to meet these requirements.
