**Gospel:** Luke 17:11-19

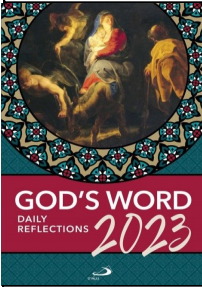
**Communions Antiphon:** The rich suffer want and go hungry, but those who seek the Lord lack no blessing.

### Gratitude to God- Let God be the glory.

Today's readings remind us of the need to count our blessings and be people of gratitude. The first reading comes from extraordinary deeds performed by the prophet Elisha. In this recount, Naaman, a general of the Aram (Syria) was seeking a cure for his skin disease. Namman was instructed to bathe seven times in the Jordan river. He did so and was cured and thanked Elisha and the prophet's God. In the Gospel, Luke tells the cure of the ten lepers. Once cured, Jesus asked them to show themselves to a priest to verify that they have been cured, as per the Jewish Law of Moses. Only one of former lepers returned to Jesus to thank him and praise God. Jesus said; "Your faith has saved you".

Faith had also saved a Jesuit priest named Fr Walter Cizek as well as many prisoners of war survivors of World War 2. When Fr Cizek was released 18 years later from imprisonments in slave labour camps in Siberia, the secret of his survival was his faith. With post traumatic stress disorder becoming common these days, it seems that the lack of faith has magnified the trauma that people of today are confronted with. For faith is the tool to feel love and courage and also it forms a relationship between God and ourselves, which when strong, gives us strength.

The Sacrament of First Holy Communion is offered to children who have made their Reconciliation sacrament and are in Yr 3 or above. The Holy Communion will be held on Sunday 6th November at 12:30pm. Forms are available at the back of the church for the enrolment to the sacrament and due by this Monday 10th October. Lessons commence on Friday 14th October.

Cost \$7995 per person (twin share), (\$1400 single room supplement)

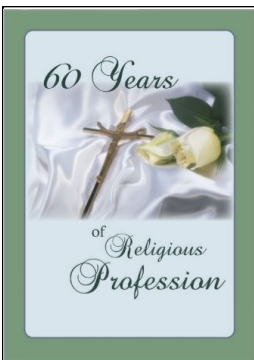
