Gospel: Luke 18:1-8

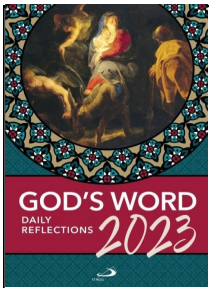

Persevere in Prayer

Prayer with faith and perseverance is the theme in the readings today. In the first readings from Exodus, God grants victory to the Israelites while sanctioning the slaughter of the Amalekites who were the superior force, but only through the intercession of Moses, raising his arm in prayer, did victory fall to the Israelites. Did God play favouritism for one and condemn the other who worshipped another god?

In the Gospel, Jesus uses the parable to show the importance of persistence and perseverance in prayer. In this case the persistence in a petition grants the poor woman the outcome desired from the judge.

Some people would say that prayer can give false sense of expectation or the repetition of a prayer might support indoctrination. Jesus is saying that prayer opens to God, it changes us for the better, it calms the mind and heart when there is a lack of sense in the world. We are then able to understand the divine mystery and follow God's will.

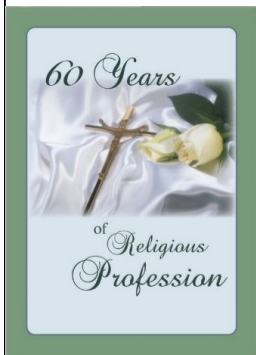
Mass will be celebrated for Sr Tess at Christ the King Church 10.30 am on Tuesday 18th October 2022. Everyone is welcome.

Safeguarding requirements

A WWC check is required in order to volunteer for reading, Eucharist for the sick and for Acolytes, a Working With Children Check number (WWC), is free to volunteers and to apply via Services NSW website. A WWC number can take 4-6 weeks to receive. We then send the verified and cleared volunteers list to the Archdioceses.

Catholic Mission Appeal –23rd October– Mission Sunday

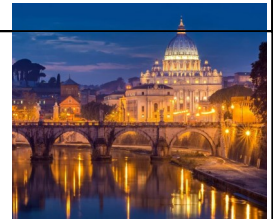
