Belonging

This week's readings is centred on Belonging.

In the boof of Wisdom, God always welcomes those who realise their errors and makes effort to turn their life around. God is the living god, found amongst us living things and in all creatures.

In the second reading— Paul is urging his people to pray that they continue to be faithful to following Christ. Belonging to be Christlike.

In the Gospel— Jesus encounters Zacchaeus, a tax collector living in Jericho. Zacchaeus is seen as a “sinner” and an outsider to the Jewish community. Curious by the presence of the Holy man Jesus, Zacchaeus climbs the tree when Jesus notices him and invites Himself to Zacchaeus home. Zacchaeus is open, honest and acknowledges his faults, regrets and promises to make amends for his wrongdoing. This is true repentance. Zacchaeus not only is a member of his family, but a member belonging to Christ. Salvation, healing and wholeness are the very definition of Catholic belonging.

How do I understand my own sense of belonging— my belonging to my nation, my family, my Church? Do I foster a “us against them” mentality? How open am I willing to change for the better? Would I protect the truth and my Catholic beliefs? This is what we face today.

A WWC check is required in order to volunteer for reading, Eucharist for the sick and for Acolytes, a Working With Children Check number (WWC), is free to volunteers and to apply via Services NSW website. A WWC number can take 4-6 weeks to receive. We then send the verified and cleared volunteers list to the Archdioceses.
