End of our Times

This week's readings go further than last weeks teaching on life after death and the resurrection of the soul. This is the "end of the liturgical year's ordinary time". In the first reading, in the book of Malachi, it raises the importance of the relationship between God and Israel, to remain faithful to their God and make efforts to restore the relationship with God when the relationship breaks down. When the Israelites remain faithful to God, and live according to the covenant, they will receive divine justice or blessings.

In the Gospel, Jesus reminds us that the physical temple, although seen as a divine splendour, can be easily desecrated by others who have no care for our God. Jesus is telling us, that we are our own temple and only we can destroy our own soul. We must always be ready for the coming of Christ, be strong and firm in our beliefs and live the Christian life. For endurance and commitment in Christ wins our lives in eternity. What remains on earth is our name on a plaque, and a memory left to our loved ones that we lived a good, truthful, honest and caring life. But Christ sees our victory over suffering and evil.
