Christ the King

This week's readings focus on the theme of kingship. The first reading reflects on the magnitude of the reputation and charismatic figure of King David in around 1000BC. David was a much stronger King than Saul, successfully fought off

the Philistine. David was anointed as King and regarded as the ultimate messiah. In the Gospel, the reading takes us to the crucifixion, where Jesus is crowned "King of the Jews". But the traditional Jews never embraced Jesus. It is the Christians who crowned him King of Kings. Jesus is reluctant to be crowned King, but we see him the ruler of wisdom, truth, courage, peace and service to God. He never commanded respect but is respected for his teaching, spirituality, and his love of people and obedience to God. He represented Divinity.

As we look forward to a new liturgical year, reflect on the past, we examine our own failures and responsibilities, then reconcile with Christ, so we can be saved, inherit the light and eventually join the saints in His eternal Kingdom.
