First Reading: Isaiah 2:1-5

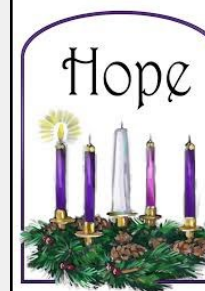
Response: Let us go rejoicing to the house of the Lord.

In the Gospel, Matthew is stressing to be vigilant and prepare themselves, make good changes, reassess our priorities as this is not the time to self-indulge. For those who are foolish and unprepared will miss out should the Messiah appear and call for them. They will be left in the dark. Anytime, is a good time to appreciate and thank those we love, and the gifts we see around us. Advent is a time of waiting in hope.

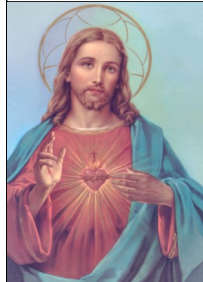
The **candle of Hope or Prophecy candle** symbolises the hope from our faithful God for His promise he made to us.
