Entrance Antiphon: O sing a new song to the Lord; sing to the Lord, all the earth. In his presence are majesty and splendour, strength and honour in his holy place.

Sharing the light of Christ.

The fulfilment of the prophecy brings reassurance of God's promise for his people. In relation to Jesus being the Messiah, Matthew points out at Isiah's prophecy, that the Messiah will begin his ministry in Galilee. This is where Jesus starts his preaching and teaching. How do we know when to recognise a sign that God is trying to communicate with us?

In Paul's letter to the Corinthians, Paul's letter gives us insight into Chloe, a business woman, who is an "influencer", is on "Team Jesus", and participates in the life of the early Church. Paul says that many allegiances to teams may cause conflict and unrest, that only the full commitment to Christ is the only way to live. This is what Pope Francis is trying to achieve in his papacy.

As Jesus is gathering his disciples, preaching and healing the sick, he hears that John the Baptist is arrested. Jesus knows that to spread the Good news and proclaim to the world of God's love, that he cannot do it alone! Like lighting a candle in a dark corner of the world, and allowing it to spread with the help of the disciples, by doing so, salvation is in reach for the whole world. We can imagine our roll in this mission, and that is to share it and live it!

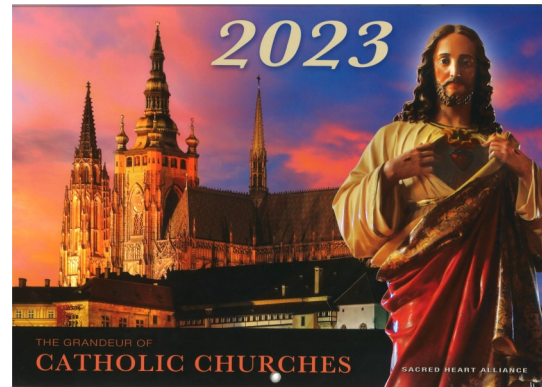
