## The Ascension Of The Lord 21st May 2023 YEAR A

**Entrance Antiphon:** Men of Galilee, why gaze in wonder at the heavens? This Jesus whom you saw ascending into heaven will return as you saw him go,

First Reading: Acts 1:1-11

**Response:** God mounts the throne to shouts of joy: a blare of trumpets for the Lord.

Second Reading: Ephesians 1:17-23

Gospel Acclamation: Alleluia, alleluia! Go and teach all people my gospel. I am with you always, until the end of the world. Alleluia!

**Gospel:** Matthew 28:16-20

Communion Antiphon: Behold, I am with you always, even to the end of the age, alleluia.



#### The Feast of the Ascension of the Lord.

Today is the commemoration of Christ's exaltation following his resurrection from the dead. In the first reading Luke, the writer of the Acts of the Apostles, depicts Jesus' ascension into heaven. In the Second reading Paul tells us that, as a result of the Easter mystery. Christ is now the supreme power in the universe. Jesus' time has come to be with God in the state of eternal happiness and glory-Heaven.

For the past 40 days we have heard Jesus's instructions, Will and final testaments to his disciples and the promise of the presence of the Holy Spirit. In today's Gospel, the risen Jesus appears to the remaining eleven male disciples in Galilee – he has previously appeared only to the women. Jesus commissions these reconciled disciples for mission: they are to "make disciples of all the nations", and the sign that someone has accepted the message is that they will be baptised. Celebrating baptism, along with the Eucharist, means that we are declaring publicly that we are disciples of Jesus. Jesus has not left us: he is present to his disciples today, as he was to Mary Magdalene and the other disciples, though in a different way. His final words are addressed to us: that we should continue his work of revealing what God is like by the example of our lives. Most of us are not called to go elsewhere and make disciples, but we are all called on to preach the Gospel: this will not usually mean by what we say or do, but rather by the kind of person we are.

Please welcome the family and children of Christ the King Primary school who will be doing the readings for the 10am Family Mass.
