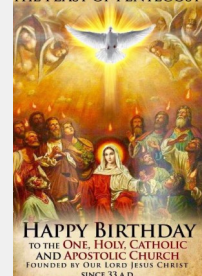
Entrance Antiphon: The love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Spirit of God dwelling within us, alleluia.

THE FEAST OF PENTECOST



The Feast of Pentecost

Today we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the church. Pentecost comes from the Greek phrase "the 50th day"...after the Passover. In the first reading, Luke describes how the Holy Spirit is poured out on the disciples of Jesus. Hiding behind closed doors, the Holy Spirit awakened the scared disciples, giving them confidence to take the message of Jesus to the wide world. With the Holy Spirit, the disciples received the strength, courage and enthusiasm to be missionaries of

Christ. They were able to speak and understand many languages. In the second reading, the apostle Paul reflects on the gifts of the Spirit in the lives of believers and encourages us to play our part, whatever that may be, in building up the life of our community. In the Gospel, John recounts on the risen Jesus makes himself present to his disciples and commissions them to carry on his work. Jesus breathing on his disciples, sharing and gifting with them his own Holy Spirit. As the disciples spread the word, Christian developments and communities form with the same longing for the relationship with God. This becomes the Church and today, we celebrate the Birthday of the Church.

Recently, and as part of the synodal process, we have been encouraged to discuss what it means to be a disciple of Jesus and how to carry Jesus' message to people who have not heard it, or who have been hurt in a way that has led them to reject the Church and its ministers. Perhaps the most important element in all this is that we *listen* to one another, that we try to understand our fellow disciples and live in unity, in peace and harmony.
